

GATE PAGER

Prevent visitors wandering about your farm spreading disease, trying to find you!

TRANSMITTER PANEL

The Transmitter is mounted in the site office or in a dry area, and is connected to a mains supply (note the unit is fixed with a 12v dc rechargeable supply to back the system up for mains supply failure) the push button unit is connected to the transmitter panel by two low voltage wires.

The gate pager is a three channel system so it is possible to connect the existing alarm system to one spare channel and the site phone to the third channel. For example, a visitor at the gate would be code A, and an alarm call would be code B and code C could be site telephoning is ringing.



THE POCKET PAGER

2-LINE / 4-LINE ALPHANUMERIC PAGER

Four button operation with icon driven menu options make the pager quick and easy to use. There are two selectable display modes; 4 lines of 20 characters or 2 lines of 12 characters. The two-line display with its large characters is ideal for applications such as Assistance Call where it is vital that the call is read and acted upon quickly. Add to this a compact ergonomic case design and USB charging and you have a classic pager suitable for most paging applications.



PUSH BUTTON

The Push Button unit is mounted at the gate or the site office or at a point you require visitors to wait for your attention.
